UPBEAT Safety Management Policy

We will do our best to create a safe environment for the students, based on the school's safety management policy, while paying attention to everyone's hygiene management.

For those participating in the Summer Course, please check the following guidelines and information.

Please submit the “Past 2 Weeks Temperature Record” Form to the office on the first day of school.

If the records cannot be submitted, students will not be allowed to enter the school premises or join the class.

◆ Student Requirements When Entering the School Premises



- We recommend that all students **wear a mask during indoor activities.**
- We recommend that all students **take off a mask during outdoor activities.**
 - *Depending on the temperature and COVID-19 situation, we may change this policy.
- Entrance Temperature Check: Students who have temperature of 37.5 or above are not allowed to enter the school.
- Disinfecting: Use the alcohol hand spray to disinfect.

◆ Parents Entering the Campus

- For parents or guardians entering the campus, please adhere to the following procedures,

1) Temperature Measurement 2) Hand Disinfection

◆ Safety Measures

Staff members will avoid direct physical contact (i.e. hugs, hi-fives, handshaking, etc.) as much as possible.
